2. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The organising authority for the event is the Model Yachting Association (MYA) and responsibility for the management of the event is delegated by the MYA to Lincoln Radio Sailing Club.

3. RULES

The event will be governed by the current version of the following rules:

- Racing Rules of Sailing as changed by the RRS Appendix E
- Equipment Rules of Sailing
- MYA Ranking Regulations
- MYA Standard Sailing Instructions
- Class Rules
- MYA Heat Management System (HMS)

Copies of the above may be viewed on the Official Notice Board at the event.

Before the event copies of the above may be found in the Race and Event section of the MYA Knowledge Base.

4. REGISTRATION

The following shall be presented to the Race Committee at the time requested.

- valid class certificate for the boat to be raced
- if applicable, the owner’s valid personal sail number certificate
- emergency contact details
- for foreign competitors, proof of membership of their Delegated National Member

If any of the above is not available at the event, but a competitor claims that they exist, the competitor shall sign a declaration to that effect and send a copy of the missing document to the Race Committee within seven days of the end of the event.

5. SCORING AND RACING SYSTEM

Scoring and Racing System shall be as per Section 4.

6. MEASUREMENT

The Race Committee may direct that boats in the event shall be check measured. Random spot checks may be conducted throughout the duration of the event.

7. FREQUENCIES

Permitted frequencies are 27 MHz, 40 MHz and 2.4 GHz

For frequency bands other than 2.4GHz, a minimum of five (5) frequencies shall be stated on the entry form and be available at the event.

8. PROTESTS

A protest committee will be appointed by the Race Committee to hear any protests arising from the event and may comprise competitors not involved in the incident.

9. ENTRIES & ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to all MYA members and is also open to members of foreign clubs affiliated to a Delegated National Member of IRSA.

The number of entries shall be limited by the provisions of the Heat Management System (HMS).

Entries shall be made before the closing date for entries, 25th May 2023 as follows:

- Online, using the on-line entry system via the MYA website.
- By e-mail attaching a completed event entry form to jen.hand@outlook.com

After the closing date late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organising authority and may incur an additional late entry fee.

10. ENTRY FEES

The entry fee of £10.00 per day and shall be paid using the Online Payment System. The entry will only be valid once the entry fee has been received by the Organising Committee by the due date.

11. COMPETITORS WITH DISABILITY

Competitors that require any form of help or special requirements should, prior to entry, get in touch with the club contact given in Section 10 to check if the club is able to help with the provision of any such special requirements. The onus is on the competitor to establish whether the available facilities are adequate before deciding to enter the event

12. PRIZES AND TROPHIES

Prizes will be awarded based on the number of entries as soon as possible after racing.

13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

All those entering or taking part in this event do so at their own risk and responsibility.

The Model Yachting Association, the organising authority, the host club and any other parties involved in the organisation of this event disclaim any and every responsibility whatsoever for loss, damage, injury or inconvenience that might occur to persons and goods both ashore or on the water as a consequence of entering or participating in the event covered by this Notice of Race.

At all times the responsibility for the safety of their boat and themselves plus the decision to participate or continue must rest with the competitor.

14. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

There is plenty of free parking at the lakeside. If you would like to camp overnight, there is a small charge of £5/night, but there are no facilities on site. Please advise in advance if staying overnight.
